Background

Catholic institutions and Catholic educators have been rendering yeoman service to society in the true spirit of catholic orientation in education. However, since 2015 there have been recurrent and topical issues in the general debate reflecting the need for a more precise awareness and consistency of the Catholic identity of the Church's educational institutions worldwide.

At the same time, the Congregation for Catholic education has been confronted with cases of conflicts and appeals resulting from different interpretations of the traditional concept of Catholic identity by educational institutions in the face of the rapid changes that have taken place in recent years. In this emerging context, the challenges of Catholic identity during the process of globalisation have emerged in parallel with the growth of interreligious and intercultural dialogue and need to be discussed.

At this juncture, it is apt and appropriate to delve into a more in-depth and up-to-date reflection and guidelines on what is Catholic identity of those who lead catholic institutions at the helm and those who engage with the future generation. Hence the seminar emphasises it is necessary that principals of schools, teacher educators in training colleges and teachers who are catholic value the Catholic identity in leadership practices and in the education process in educational institutions of the Church. This will enable educators to provide and articulate a set of criteria responding to the challenges of our times, in continuity with the standards that always apply and engage in a positive dialogue. This seminar reverberates the idea of Pope Francis, "We cannot create a culture of dialogue if we do not have an identity."

The University

CHRIST (Deemed to be University) was born out of the educational vision of St Kuriakose Elias Chavara, an educationalist and social reformer of the nineteenth century in South India. He founded the first Catholic indigenous congregation, Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI), in 1831 which administers CHRIST (Deemed to be University).

"CHRIST (Deemed to be University) was established as 'Christ College' in 1969. It undertook path-breaking initiatives in Indian higher education with the introduction of innovative and modern curricula, insistence on academic discipline, imparting of Holistic Education and adoption of global higher education practices with the support of creative and dedicated staff."

The University Grants Commission (UGC) of India conferred Autonomy to Christ College in 2004 and identified it as an Institution with Potential for Excellence in 2006. In 2008 under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Ministry of Human Resource Development of the Government of India, declared the institution a Deemed to be University, in the name and style of Christ University. One of the first institutions in India to be accredited in 1998 by the NAAC, and subsequently in 2004 and 2016, CHRIST (Deemed to be University) has the top grade 'A' in the 4-point scale.

The multi-disciplinary University which focuses on teaching research and service offers Bachelor, Master and Doctoral programmes in humanities, social sciences, sciences, commerce, management, engineering, architecture, education, and law to about 25000 students. The University offers its programmes at three campus locations in Bangalore in Karnataka; in Pune Lavasa in Maharashtra and Delhi NCR.
